The PARADISO project in a nutshell

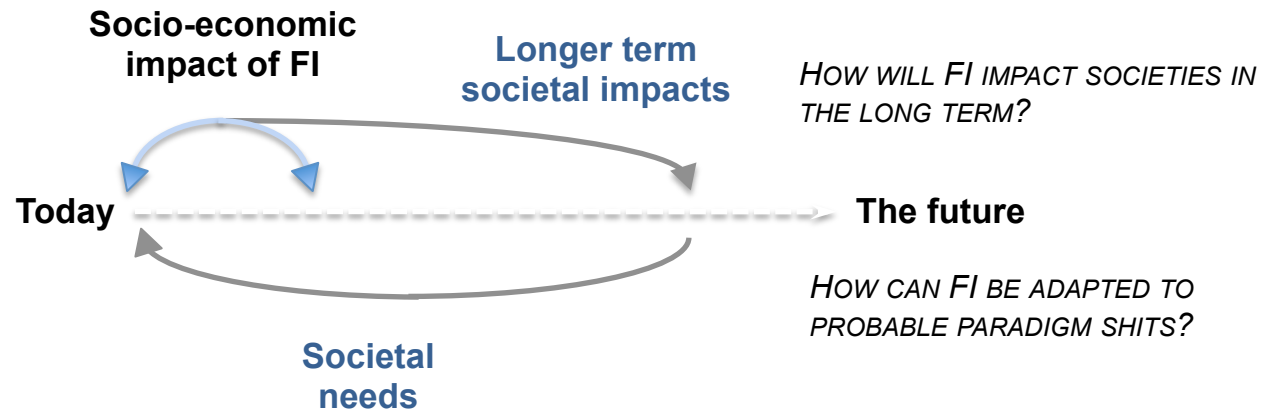
- **Launched at the initiative of the Club of Rome**

 - ❖ A multi-disciplinary NoE addressing trustworthiness issues in a holistic way
 - ❖ A support action involving leading non-EU countries, complementing the present international portfolio and focusing on standards, certification and best practices
